It always shows TypeError: weigh() missing 1 required positional argument: 'right'
seems there is a "self" position not filled and I add the first position with 'Balls' like
"Balls.weigh(Balls,[1,2,3,4], [5,6,7,8])"
then It says _weigh() missing 1 required positional argument: 'right'
or _check_balls missing 1 required positional argument: 'right'
or _check_iterable missing 1 required positional argument: 'a'
or AttributeError: type object 'Balls' has no attribute 'n_calls'
```
