for example `"Balls.weigh([1,2,3,4], [5,6,7,8])"`

It always shows `TypeError: weigh() missing 1 required positional argument: 'right'`

seems there is a "self" position not filled

and I add the first position with 'Balls' like

`"Balls.weigh(Balls,[1,2,3,4], [5,6,7,8])"`

then It says `_weigh() missing 1 required positional argument: 'right'`

or `_check_balls missing 1 required positional argument: 'right'`

or `_check_iterable missing 1 required positional argument: 'a'`

or `AttributeError: type object 'Balls' has no attribute 'n_calls'`
