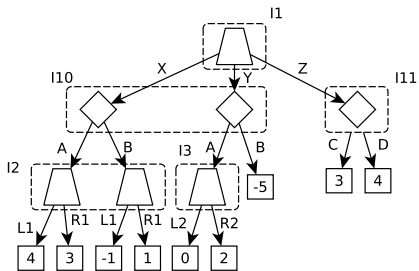

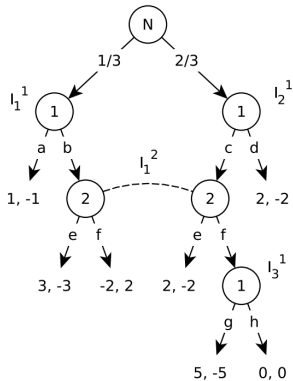

Task 2: Consider the following games. Write down a sequence-form linear program for both players:



Task 3: Write down a sequence-form linear program for both players for the following game of a small “poker”:

- there is an ante of 1\$
- there is a limited deck of cards $\{J, J, Q, Q\}$
- each player receives a card
- player 1 either folds or bets 2\$
- player 2 either calls or folds
- player with the higher card wins
